— with their nanny and went for postpartum therapy.

While at the therapist’s office, the fire alarm went off. Tragically, Kim was one of the five people who didn’t make it out alive.

With Ike out of the country and no guardians legally appointed, first responders placed the children in Child Protective Services. The closest relatives lived out of state. No plan was in place. They had meant to get to it, but like most parents, other “more urgent” things got in the way.

Julie fell into a coma for nearly four months after being harmed in a foster home. By the time she woke up, she barely recognized her father and brother. If there had been a plan, the children could have stayed with a trusted caregiver — in their home — safe until Dad returned.

The 5 Legal Essentials Every Parent Needs

1. Immediate Guardian Nomination

Without this, your children could be placed with strangers or in state custody until a judge decides. You need someone with legal permission to step in immediately.

2. Long-Term Guardian Designation

This person would raise your child if you couldn't. Verbal wishes aren't enough — they must be documented, legally.

3. Choosing the Right Guardian

Don't default to your oldest sibling or closest relative. Consider emotional readiness, parenting style, faith, and location. Choose

4. Temporary Care Instructions

What happens if you're delayed on a trip or taken to the hospital? A neighbor, friend, or nanny can step in — but only if you've legally empowered them. Make sure they have written instructions and temporary authority.

5. Legal Documents Parents Need

Your full plan should include:

- Guardian nominations (immediate + long-term)
- Powers of attorney
- Health care proxies
